COMPLICATED CONTROLS of electro-encephalograph, a sensitive machine which records electric impulses of the brain, are adjusted by Dr. Donald R. Gunn, research head at Ontario Hospital. The recently installed piece of equipment is used to trace organic damage in the brain, such as tumors. Electrodes are attached to patient's head and pattern traced on a graph indicates whether brain damage exists.
