book: The Prayer

- in Surah Muzzamil, there was a verse where it was compulsory for the Muslims to pray at night, except for a bit.

Initially, only the first part of the verse was revealed. The night prayer then was an obligation, because Allah wanted to shape the people with certain qualities, especially those people that were going to be the first leaders of Islam. It distances people from sin. Then Allah completed the verse by revealing, "except a little".

There is a hadith that says there is no man or female upon which a knot is not tied on his head at night; if you wake up and remember Allah a knot is untied, and if you do wadoo, another knot is untied. These knots are originally tied by Shaytaan.

There is another hadith that says if you die and if there are 40/100 people who pray Janaza over you, i.e. people that have never associated anyone with God, then Allah will accept their prayer

- it is so good to pray janaza and there is so much reward for both parties
- the intercession of all the people praying will be accepted

In another hadith it says that when you commit sin and you really want forgiveness, you try to perfect your wadoo, pray 2 rakaats, then ask Allah to forgive you, then you will be forgiven. So you should try to do all your prayers this way.

There is another hadith which says that if a poor person prays, his dua will be accepted and aids in the victory of the ummah, so you need to make sure that you educate the poor on prayer and Quran.

Salaatut-Tasbih - if you have sins, old and new, deliberate and not, hidden and open - all these sins will be forgiven if you pray salatut tasbih, and this causes forgiveness of sin and increases iman.

How to pray:

1. 4 rakaats
2. In each rakaat recite Fatiha and another surah
3. When you are standing after your 1st rakaat, you should say subhanallah, alhamdulillah, La illaha Illahlla and Allahu Akbar 15 times
4. then you bow down and say all 10 times
5. Raise up your head from rukoo and say it 10 times
6. Prostrate and say it 10 times
7. Raise your head from prostration and say it 10 times
8. Prostrate and say it 10 times

= 75 times in every rakaat, which you do in 4 rakats.

- subhanallah - if you are able to, do it once a day, if not then once a week, if not then once a month, if not then once in your life time.

- Allah always give us chances to repent, Subhanallah!

There is an ayah in surah al –imran (3:135)

- if you commit adultery, there is a forgiveness.

-doing perfect wadoo and praying perfectly is even good enough to forgive sins such as adultery.

- In the Quran the verses encourage hastiness (i.e. pray immediately after you commit the sin, or ASAP) but in human nature we always procrastinate
