D. ACADEMIC HISTORY:

1. Research Interests:

My research training in Respirology was in pulmonary physiology and specifically in lung mechanics, both at the University of Toronto and at the Mayo Clinic. Following my appointment at the Wellesley Hospital, University of Toronto, I was involved in descriptive reports of clinical problems but also used this background in physiology in studies such as the clinical use of helium and the description of bronchiolitis. I also contributed to the interpretation of physiologic abnormalities in epidemiologic surveys of grain workers and patients with rheumatoid disease.

Growing commitments in education and administration with my move to the Toronto General Hospital in the late 1980s reduced my activities in biomedical studies, but this was coupled with a growth in my long-standing interest in the cultural contexts within which medicine is practiced. This had previously led to research in semiotics and an investigation of pharmaceutical advertising. Along with my collaborator and spouse, Professor Linda Hutcheon (Department of English and Centre for Comparative Literature, University of Toronto), I have explored the meanings taken on by illnesses and the people who have them when medical information is interpreted in a social or cultural context. We have used opera as the cultural vehicle for explorations that have led to the publication of four books. This has been my primary academic interest for the past twenty years.

With my involvement in lung transplantation, I have played an active collaborative role in clinical research in this program. My particular role includes the design and conduct of clinical trials and acting as a resource for questions regarding lung mechanics.
