*Conventions used:* Square ([...]) and pointy-angle (<...>) brackets are used where Gál and Flood used them: the former enclose the titles of documents and numbers of canons and chapters that the editors added, while the latter enclose words and sentences added by the editors. In my suggested emendations, I have used the square brackets like Gál and Flood; regular angle brackets (<...>) were used to mark letters, words, or phrases that I believe should be added to the text. The numbers in bold refer to the page numbers of the *Chronica*.

[d.p.c. 7] *Hoc autem*, et [D. 19 d.p.c. 8] *Quia* {ergo} (?) et c. [9] *Anastasius*, in textu et glossa.
- Regarding my suggested emendation from *Quia vero* (in G&F) and *Quia ergo*, if the emendation is incorrect, it might be a reference to one of these three: D. 6 d.a.c. 1; C. 24 q. 3 d.p.c. 25; D. 2 de cons. c. 1. One should check the glosses to C. 24 q. 1 c. 1 and C. 24 q. 1 c. 3.

- 924–25** Combine the paragraphs beginning ‘Cum igitur manifestum...’ and ‘Et ego <qui>’ into one paragraph. The logic of this combined paragraph reads thus: ‘Since it is clear that he who does X does not recede from the Church (etc.), and I did X, I am compelled to be not a little amazed that some say that I have receded from the Church....’ Note that this also does away with the need for the <qui> supplied by the editors.
