Studying Strategy

- Make outline of all topics (see topic outline)
 - Go over main lecture topics first What were main concepts?
 - · Then fill in subtopics
 - · Then sub-subtopics, etc.

 - What is in text that relates to these concepts, or was assigned reading to complement these topics?
 - Look at lab assignments
 - You are expected to know all concepts and functions you learned in the lab.

Exam Writing Strategy

- If you are not sure what a question means, ask me
 - but do NOT ask me
 - "am I on the right track?"
 - "does this look right?"
 - · "what are you looking for?"
 - I will not give hints
- Make sure you understand terminology, so you know what I am asking you

Exam Writing Strategy - Suggestions...

- Use number of marks to budget your time (i.e., do long answer first, then short answer, then multiple choice)
- Write point form outline on back to organize your thoughts
- Make sure you have answered all parts of the question
- Do not pad your answer with irrelevant information
 Use diagrams if you think they help answer the question
- Underline key words, such as functions or key concepts Use headings where appropriate
- Long answer does not mean 20 pages.
