### **Research interests:**

- 1) Shadow economy, organized crime, corruption (including that in law enforcement agencies);
- 2) Clan capitalism in Russia and other countries;
- 3) Social change, transformation of societies: comparative analysis;
- 4) Methodology of social research
- 5) Socioeconomic issues of post-Soviet military-industrial complex;
- 6) Innovation and its economic and sociopolitical obstacles.

There were carried out interdisciplinary studies combining research in sociology, political science and economics. Over the period of twenty years it has been completed more than 60 large-scale research projects on model of capitalism in Russia, problems of criminal control, corruption and shadow economy, motivation of labor, labor-management relations, social factors of the post-Cold War restructuring of the Russian military-industrial complex, social machinery for innovation, social problems of transformation in the R&D sector, construction, agriculture, social services. Many of these studies were carried out in cooperation with European, Japanese and US scholars, and their results were published in English and in other languages.

Selected recent research projects are as follows:

1. Comparative survey-based study of economic corruption of the law enforcement officers in a several transformation countries: Russia, Bulgaria, Kazakhstan and Latvia (with Denis Strebkov, Elena Berdysheva, Tatiana Karabchuk, Anastasia

- Dubova, Maria Kravtsova, Alexei Belianin). This study is an extension of an earlier research done in Russia and funded by the Soros Foundation.
2. Broad comparative analysis of the newly emerged Russian socioeconomic system entitled “Clan capitalism in Russia and its elements in other transition countries” including study of the explicit and hidden interactions between major actors in the economy and politics.
  3. “Informality and Modernization” (with Chris Swader, HSE) based on the data of the World Values Survey. Analysis of the interplay between informal business relations, primary human relations and modernization with special focus on analysis of anomie in the transformation and well-established countries.
  4. “Understanding Nascent Capitalism in Eastern Europe” – project of comparative studies done within the Institute of Human Sciences, Austria. Head of the project is János M. Kovács, research team includes Paul Dragos Aligica, Bucharest; Roumen Avramov, Sofia; Jacek Kochanowicz, Warsaw; Mladen Lazić, Belgrade; Violetta Zentai, Budapest. This Project aims to compare the emerging capitalist regimes in six countries of Eastern Europe: Bulgaria, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Russia, and Serbia. It includes four research fields: 1) Property rights and privatization regimes; 2) Institutions of market regulation; 3) Welfare regimes; and 4) The political economy.

Studies were resulted in near 170 publications, including academic papers, papers presented to policy-making bodies and articles in general press.
