Dictionaries, Grammar texts, notes, as well as any electronic devices including Blackberries, cellular telephones, USB keys are not permitted into the testing room.

The test will be completed by students in their schools under the supervision of an Invigilator (form available from the Contest website). <u>Before they access the test</u>, all students are required to sign the Contest Invigilator's Form.

The Contest Invigilator will record the start and end times for each student.

The total time allotted for completing the test is <u>60 minutes</u>. However, students can start writing their test at any time between 9:30-11:30 a.m.

There will be two types of tests, according to the participants' categories:

Core French and Core French Plus students will complete the Test entitled **Core French**.

French Immersion and Extended French students will complete the Test entitled **Immersion.**

After clicking on the contest link, students will be prompted to ad

Only after completing the three required fields, students will be allowed to start their test.

The three sections of the on-line test are as follows:

- 1. Test de compréhension auditive
- 2. Test de connaissance de la culture
- 3. Rédaction d'une composition

Important Tips for all participants:

- Read the instructions for each section attentively.
- Ensure that you do not exceed the time limit allowed for your test (60 minutes): the start and end times for each participant are automatically recorded. Therefore, responses which exceed 60 minutes might not be considered.
- For the section entitled *Composition*, use the <u>accent board</u> provided within the test; copy and paste each letter as needed.
- Within the test, you can freely move back and forth between pages by using the PREV and NEXT buttons.
- After completing the test, you MUST click DONE to submit your test answers.
