Stage Direction:

The singer is to be at the front of stage, harpsichord and cello slightly behind him; the singer takes stage right, harpsichord roughly centred, and cello at stage left. In the instrumental interlude in m.43-51, the singer can then turn slightly to the cellist so show he is "listening" and still partially face the audience.

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
